

## **CRITERIA FOR NOMINATION AS PAM DIPLOMATE**

(Approved during the Annual Meeting of PAM, Inc. on July 18, 2023)

### **A. DIPLOMATE FROM THE ACADEME/RESEARCH INSTITUTION**

1. Must be nominated by a PAM Diplomat or Fellow.
2. Must be a life member of a microbiology-related professional organization.
3. Must be of good moral character, as attested by his/her supervisor.
4. Must be a PAM-certified Registered Microbiologist (RMicro) or Specialist Microbiologist (SMicro).
5. Must possess at least an MS degree in Microbiology or a related field.
6. Must have at least ten (10) years of experience in teaching, research, and/or practice in microbiology.
7. Must have at least five (5) articles in microbiology published in ISI/WoS/Scopus-indexed journals within the last seven (7) years, of which at least two (2) have the nominee as the lead or corresponding author. The articles should not have been previously used as equivalencies for the certification as RMicro without exam.
8. Must have garnered two (2) national/international professional awards in the field of microbiology. For awards that are ranked, only first placers are considered. University awards are not categorized as national awards.
9. Three (3) publications in microbiology in ISI/WoS/Scopus-indexed journals with the nominee as the lead/corresponding author can be used to replace one of the required national/international awards. These are in addition to the required number of publications.
- 10.10. Must have attended at least three (3) annual conventions of a microbiology-related professional organization in the last five (5) years. When applicable, one of the three required annual convention attendance can be replaced by attendance in two cluster symposia, or two regional symposia or conventions.

### **MS/Doctorate degree holders certified as RMicro without taking the certification examination must satisfy the following additional requirements:**

11. Must have a one-year residency as RMicro.
12. The articles used in the substitution for the microbiology units (used in the RMicro application) can no longer be used for substitution for national/international awards.

8	Proofs of at least two (2) national/international professional awards in the field of microbiology. For awards that are ranked, only first placers are considered. University awards are not categorized as national awards.		
9	If applicable: Proofs of three (3) additional publications in microbiology in ISI/WoS/Scopus-indexed journals with him or her as the lead /corresponding author can be used to replace one of the required national/international awards. Note: Substitution of three (3) ISI/ WoS/Scopus-indexed articles for one national award can only be done once for Diplomate/Fellow membership to PAM		
10	Proof of attendance to at least three (3) annual conventions of a microbiology-related professional organization in the last five (5) years. One of the three required annual convention attendance can be replaced by attendance in two cluster symposia, or two regional symposia or conventions.		
11	Doctorate/MS degree holders certified as RMicro without taking the certification examination must satisfy the

**B. DIPLOMATE FROM THE INDUSTRY**

1. Must be nominated by a PAM Diplomat or Fellow.
2. Must be a life member of a microbiology-related professional organization.
3. Must be of good moral character, as attested by his/her supervisor.
4. Must be a PAM-certified Registered Microbiologist (RMicro) or Specialist Microbiologist (SMicro).
5. Must possess at least an MS degree in Microbiology or a related field.
6. Must have at least ten (10) years of experience in the practice of microbiology.
7. Must have accomplished or undertaken at least ten (10) of any combination of the following:
  - a. Improved/modified a microbiology-related procedure (i.e., assay) used in the company. The company should be implementing the improved/modified procedure.
  - b. Solved through research a microbiology-related problem of the company.
  - c. Introduced a new, applicable microbiology-related process to the company.
  - d. Developed, tested, and registered a microbiology-related product that is currently commercialized or sold in the market.

Note: Certification by the company on items 7a to 7d must be forwarded to the CBd.

8. Must have garnered at least two (2) national/international professional awards in the field of microbiology. For awards that are ranked, only first placers are considered. University/ Institutional awards are not categorized as national awards. Five (5) publications in ISI/WoS/Scopus-indexed journals can be used to replace one of the required national/international awards. Doctorate holders certified as RMicro without taking the certification examination can no longer use the articles *previously used in the substitution for microbiology units in the RMicro application* for the national/international award.

**OR**

Must have been given at least two (2) rank promotions by the company due to accomplishments in the field of microbiology (duly certified by the supervisor).

9. Must have attended at least three (3) annual conventions of a microbiology-related professional organization in the last five (5) years. One of the three required annual convention attendance can be replaced by attendance in two cluster symposia, or two regional symposia or conventions.
10. MS/Doctorate degree holders certified as RMicro without taking the certification examination must have a one-year residency as RMicro.
